

OFF LICENCE



Licence No: 49D/OFF/19/2025

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **HAS Beer Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **264 Cuba Street (also known as 264A Cuba Street), Te Aro, Wellington**, and known as **Heyday Beer Co**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on and delivered from the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, seven days per week, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 9.00pm

2. No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
3. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
4. The whole of the premises is designated as a **supervised** area.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption off the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
7. The licensee must at all times display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. For each principal entrance to the premises, a sign attached to the inside or outside of the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

The premises are as set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 16 October 2024.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the renewal, suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires in **3** years on: **24 November 2027**
